HOMER'S HEROES BASEBALL was founded in 1992, when the Optimist Clubs of Lincoln began providing boys and girls with a wide range of disabilities the opportunity to experience the fun and emotional development of playing in an organized baseball league.

Games: All Homer's Heroes Baseball games, with the exception of the June 22nd game, will be played on the Lewis fields at 2210 M St. Games will begin at 9:30 A.M. each Saturday beginning June 1 with the final game on July 13. The June 22nd game will be played on the UNL Women's softball field at Haymarket park. Salt Dog management, players and Homer will join us for this game.

Structure: Games will not be played according to the standard rules of baseball. Score is not kept, the goal is to provide the thrill of participation. Every attempt is made to allow each player an equal number of at bats throughout the course of a



game. Players may elect to hit off a tee or have a coach pitch.

Safety: The Optimists believe safety is the first priority. During games "Buddies" help their partners who have special needs by giving appropriate assistance as needed, such as guiding someone who

is visually impaired, using hand over hand assistance to help a child to bat or throw a ball, or pushing for a child who uses a wheelchair around the base paths. This interaction has proven to be a positive experience for all participants involved.

Team Pictures: Order forms will be passed out following the game on June 8. Team pictures will be taken at the game on June 22 at Haymarket Park. **The Optimist Clubs have secured funds to help parents with the cost of the photo for those in need of financial assistance.**

Night of Fun: Two free tickets will be available for each player to attend the June 22 Saltdogs Baseball game. Additional tickets will be available by order through Homer's Heroes Baseball, quantities will be limited. Before the game, several lucky Homer's Heroes players will escort the Saltdog players out on the field during the introductions.

Awards Night Family picnic: There will be a family night picnic following the season. Each player will receive a special award for participating in the Homer's Heroes Baseball League.
