



Junior Saltdogs League Bat Rules

All U10-U17 player bats must be inspected by a JSL rep before they can be used in a JSL game. If the bat meets the criteria below, JSL will place an orange sticker (U10-U14) or a green sticker (U17) on the bat. Our umpires will allow bats with these stickers to be used in games.

Watch the website for bat inspection dates/locations – they'll be done in late April/early May at several places in Lincoln. We strongly encourage you to use these dates as inspections at the fields during game nights will be very limited.

The following bats are approved for use in Junior Saltdogs:

U6-U8 Divisions

- No bat restrictions – any baseball bat is allowed (see length/weight guidelines on the FAQ page of our website at www.jrsaltdogs.com)
- No inspection or sticker is needed

U10-U14 Divisions

- Any non-composite barreled baseball bat
- Any baseball bat with the USA stamp (Figure A) or USSSA stamp (Figure B)
- There are no barrel diameter restrictions
- Wood bats are ok but must still have our sticker
- Inspection by JSL rep required. If approved, an orange sticker will be put on the bat

U17 Division

- Continue to use high school bat rules – bat must have the BBCOR certified stamp (Figure C) and also be a -3 or less (i.e., -2) in order to be used in a game.
- Inspection by JSL rep required. If approved, a green sticker will be put on the bat.
